What?

Working with local community leaders, we identified households in need of immediate assistance in the form of essential items and housing repair. For each household, we distributed essential items kits consisting of: powdered milk for babies, clothing for women, men, and children, and repaired their homes that were damaged by the cyclone.

Burigoalini Union and Munshiganj Union, Shyamnagar Upaila, Satkhira District, Bangladesh

When?

Start Date: June 1st, 2020

End Date: August 31st, 2020

Why?

Cyclone Amphan devastated communities in Bangladesh leaving homes destroyed and individuals vulnerable in the midst of the COVID-19 global pandemic. Penny Appeal Canada responded to this emergency in order to support the people of Satkhira District in Bangladesh during their time of need.

What was achieved?

The project provided emergency housing and clothing support to cyclone Amphan affected households in Satkhira district. With this support, beneficiaries will be able to minimise the sudden shock and domestic hardships as a result of the disaster.
