What?

Penny Appeal Canada responded to the need for Personal Protective Equipment in Canada by distributing PPE to businesses, clinics, health care centres, and community centres around Ontario:

- 980 KN95 masks,
- 36,150 Level 2 Surgical Masks
- 9400 Nitrile Gloves
- 510 face shield

Total program cost: \$21,108.88

Start Date: April 9th, 2020 End Date: July 3rd, 2020

Why?

The COVID-19 Global Pandemic overburdened the Canadian health care system and placed an increased demand for medical supplies including Personal Protective Equipment such as N95 masks, surgical masks, goggles, face shields, gowns, coveralls, gloves, and more.

With the sharp increase in demand in the first few months of the pandemic, global suppliers were unable to catch up to the need, leaving our frontline workers (health care, caregivers, and others) and essential community organizations exposed to contracting the COVID-19 virus.
