When?

Start Date: July 31st, 2020 / 10th Dhul-Hijjah

End Date: August 2nd, 2020 / 12th Dhul-Hijjah

Why?

Eid al-Adha is celebrated by Muslims around the world to commemorate the completion of Hajj. As part of this celebration, Muslims honour Prophet Ibrahim (AS) through the obligatory sacrificial slaughter of animals, known as Qurbani. Penny Appeal Canada is committed to making this religious obligation accessible.

This year, we carried out Qurbani for our donors in Bangladesh, Lebanon, Myanmar, Pakistan, Palestine, Yemen, India, Uganda, Somalia, and Canada, in order to address the immediate nutritional needs in each of these countries. With COVID-19, families who were already vulnerable are facing increased financial insecurity.

What we achieved?

We performed **4019 Qurbanis**.

- India: 2100 (shares of cow)
- Uganda: 400 (shares of goat)
- Pakistan: 350 (shares of cow)
- Myanmar: 401 (shares of cow)
- Somalia: 98 (shares of cow)
- Bangladesh: 98 (shares of cow)
- Yemen: 493 (shares of goat)
- Lebanon: 30 (shares of cow)
- Palestine: 19 (shares of cow)
- Canada: 30 (shares of lamb)

From the field

"We are one of Syrian Refugee's family who came to Lebanon 8 years ago, we are living in a very hard economic situation, NGOs used to offer us some aid, but now, it has been a long time since we received anything" as declared the grandmother.

She added a brief description of the health situation of her son: "My son is blind and injured in his hand during the Syrian war, we do not have the cost of food and water, we need the expenses of the medication for my son, we need a lot of needs like food, hygiene kit, diapers and milk for babies... but we do not have the financial capacity, we don't have even the cost of one Kg of meat during this Eid".

His wife added:" We are living a very hard economic situation, there have been 4 months since we had an appropriate meal, all NGOs stopped their support, my husband cannot work to provide us with our needs, he is blind and injured, he needs a lot of medical expenses and now his son also broke his leg and need medical attention too.

We need food, medication, hygiene kit, milk for babies... Now even the smallest meal costs us a lot of money, but in all circumstances, we thank Allah SWT, we have Allah SWT by our side first and we have you Penny Appeal Al Hamdo Lillah, we hope that you always help us and keep visiting us."
