### Who?

Penny Appeal Canada

### What?

We distributed 100 food packs to low income Zakat eligible Muslim families in a small community called Mahlabathini in Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa. This project was aimed towards low income, elderly, and orphan muslim families who were identified in collaboration with the local mosques and community organizations.

**Total Invested: \$14,000**

### Where?

Mahlabathini, Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa

### When?

**Start Date:** May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**End Date:** June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020

### Why?

Food insecurity and lack of access to nutritious food is a challenge faced by many muslim families in South Africa. This summer COVID-19 exasperated the economic difficulties families faced and increased the vulnerability of low-income, Zakat eligible, muslim families.

### What was achieved?

This project provided 100 families with food to address the immediate nutritional needs of the beneficiaries to provide them with economic relief.

**100** Food packs distributed

**100** Households served

**450** Zakat Beneficiaries



## What's in a food pack?



- 5kg flour
- 5kg Miele meal
- 10kg rice
- 2kg sugar
- Instant porridge
- 2 tins x tinned fish
- 4 tins x baked beans
- 2x tinned mixed veggies
- 100 teabags
- 1 pocket of onions
- 1 pocket potatoes
- 1kg carrots
- 2kg butternut
- 1x Cabbage heads
- Juice concentrate
- 2L sunflower oil
- 6 pack long life milk
- 2 packs biscuits.
