What?

We distributed 100 food packs to low income Zakat eligible Muslim families in a small community called Mahlabathini in Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa. This project was aimed towards low income, elderly, and orphan muslim families who were identified in collaboration with the local mosques and community organizations.

Why?

Food insecurity and lack of access to nutritious food is a challenge faced by many muslim families in South Africa. This summer COVID-19 exasperated the economic difficulties families faced and increased the vulnerability of low-income, Zakat eligible, muslim families.

What was achieved?

This project provided 100 families with food to address the immediate nutritional needs of the beneficiaries to provide them with economic relief.

100 Food packs distributed

100 Households served

450 Zakat Beneficiaries
